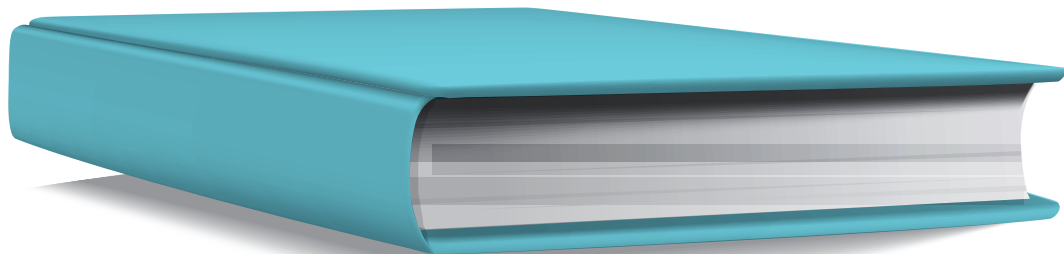


FOREWORD

PREFACE

The National Library of Uganda is the apex Library and the giant memory of the Nation. It is the intellectual store-house and the databank of learning in the remembrance process. Established by an Act of parliament 2003, one of its statutory functions is the production of the National Bibliography of Uganda (NBU). Specifically, section 2(2) of the Act mandates the National Library of Uganda “to be responsible for the development of the National Bibliography of Uganda.

The National Bibliography of Uganda (NBU) lists out, in a systematic manner, Books, serials and works in other media e.g. microforms, computer files, audio cassettes, optical disks, published in Uganda, about Uganda by Ugandans abroad and acquired by the National Library of Uganda. The National Bibliography of Uganda (NBU) is a compilation of catalogued entries of all Ugandan materials received under the legal deposit provisions during the current year (s). It is aimed at achieving National Bibliographic Control (NBC) and thereby concurrently contributing to the Universal Availability of Publications (UAP). It is therefore a useful bibliographic tool for authors, publishers, booksellers, librarians, knowledge and information managers.

This edition is published in both book and electronic formats (CD.ROM). The National Library of Uganda through the National Bibliography of Uganda is contributing immensely to the intellectual development of the nation. It is hoped that this current National Bibliography of Uganda will serve as a valuable resource material for information retrieval and research.

The National Library of Uganda wishes to passionately appeal to publishers, Authors and entire stakeholders in the book industry to fulfill their Legal Deposit-obligation by depositing the specified copies of their publications as enshrined in the legal deposit provision of the National Library of Uganda Act of 2003.

INTERNATIONAL STANDARD BOOK NUMBER

1. What is an ISBN (International Standard Book Number)?

An ISBN is a 13 –digit number that identifies a book for purposes of commerce and supply.

The ISBN is a unique international identifier for monographic (book) publications.it is a 13 digit –digit number e.g. 978-0-306-40615-0

2. What are the advantages of ISBN?

- Global ordering and distribution of books is mainly executed by ISBN
- Compilation and updating of book trade directories and bibliographic databases, such as cataloguing of books in print.
- Its need for the running of electronic point of sale systems in bookshops

3. Which materials should have ISBN?

- Monographs (books)
- E-publications.

4. Where to put the ISBN?

The thirteen (13) digit ISBN number is divided into five parts separated clearly by hyphens or spaces. E.g. 978-0-356-42615-0. This number should be printed on

- Verso title page of each publication
- Base of the title page
- Base of the spine
- The back of the cover in nine-point or larger
- The back of the dust-jacket and on the back of any other protector

5. Do books need ISBN, if they are not going to be sold?

It's desirable that **ALL** books are identified by ISBNs.

6. Does a change of format require a new ISBN?

Yes, different formats need different ISBNs.

7. I am revising a book. Does it require a new ISBN?

A significant change of text requires a new ISBN. If revisions have been made it should state on the verso of the title page that the book is revised edition and the new ISBN should be printed there.

8. Does a reprint without change of text or binding require a new ISBN?

No, not if there is no change of text, format, or building that would justify a new ISBN.

9. How are ISBNs allocated to multi-format/multi-volume works?

An ISBN must be allocated to the whole set of volumes of multi-volume work, as well as individual volumes of the set.

10. Do I need a new ISBN when I am reprinting a book with a new title?

Yes, a new title requires a new ISBN.

11. I am publishing a book with another Publisher. Whose ISBN should appear on the book?

In the case of Joint Publication, an ISBN is assigned by the publisher in charge of distribution.

12. I am not a Publisher- Can I still obtain an ISBN?

Yes, a Publisher is a group, organization, company or individual who is responsible for originating the product of a publication and also bears the cost/financial risk.

13. What are Publishers' obligations?

- Maintaining register of ISBN that have been assigned to published and forth coming books. This register should be kept in numerical sequence showing ISBN, Author, Title, Edition statements etc.
- Forwarding a list of publications with their used ISBN to the National Agency before asking for new assignment of ISBN.
- Delivering within one month of publication at his own expense to the National Library of Uganda, three copies of the book.

NATIONAL LIBRARY ACT 2003

The National Library Act 2003 applies throughout the country and has supremacy over any library Laws of state Government in the event of conflicts. Under this Act, the National Library as the National Bibliography Agency of Uganda was enjoined to receive three (3) and ten(10) copies of everything published in Uganda by private or State Agencies respectively within one month of publication at their own expense. .It is also noteworthy that the UNESCO guidelines for the collection of legal deposit materials incorporated in the National Library Act of 2003 that is:

- i. Visits to Publishers
- ii. Examinations of announcements and advertisements in national and local newspapers
- iii. Liaison with government departments and government printing offices
- iv. Establishment of an effective clerical routine of registration, receipts, checks and follow ups.

WHO IS TO DEPOSIT?

There are three categories of publishers specified in the Act:

- i. Category 1: Private Publishers
- ii. Category 2: Federal Government: Ministries, Parastatals and Agencies.
- iii. Category 3: State Government: Ministries, Parastatals and Agencies

WHAT IS TO BE DEPOSITED?

Information source that is published in Uganda. The Act in Section 4 sub-section (7) defines the “BOOK” thus:

- i. “All literary works such as Books, Pamphlets, sheets of music, maps, charts, plans. tables and compilations.
- ii. Dramatic works.
- iii. Collective works such as Encyclopedias, Dictionaries, Year Books, Newspapers, Magazines and periodicals
- iv. All forms in which documentary or oral records are published. This means legal deposit is also for non-book materials, home videos, films, cassettes etc and even electronic publications.

Please note that the best copies of each publication should be deposited.

HOW MANY IS TO BE DEPOSITED

The number of copies of published materials to be deposited varies with categories of publishers.

- i. Private publishers are to deposit three (3) copies each of their publications.
- ii. Federal government and its agencies are to deposit twenty-five (25) copies each of their publications
- iii. State government and its agencies are to deposit ten (10) copies each of their publications.

BENEFITS OF LEGAL DEPOSIT

- i. Preservation of the Nations intellectual output for future generations
- ii. Bibliographic control of the Nations Publications
- iii. The Legal deposit materials collected are processed and listed in the National Bibliography of Uganda which is circulated both locally and internationally.
- iv. The AUTHOR’s name will be entrenched in the annals of the Nation’s publication history

NATIONAL BIBLIOGRAPHY OF UGANDA, 2021 EDITION

SCOPE

This current edition of the National Bibliography of Uganda (NBU) 2021 contains catalogued entries of Ugandan materials including Books, Serials, Pamphlets and Audio-Visuals received in 2021 as Legal Deposits in accordance with the National Library of Uganda Act

ARRANGEMENT

NBU 2021 Edition is arranged in six (6) sections viz.

- i. Classified Sequence*
- ii. Author, Title and Series Index*
- iii. Subject Index*
- iv. List of Publishers and Printers*
- v. Tables of Summaries (Statistics)*
- vi. Departments in the National Library of Nigeria*

CLASSIFIED SEQUENCE SECTION

The Classified Sequence Section provides bibliographic information for all listed items and are arranged using the Dewey Decimal Classification Scheme.

AUTHOR, TITLE & SERIES INDEX

The author, title and series index is arranged in one alphabetical sequence making it possible to trace an item using either the author, the title or the series through the classification number.

SUBJECT INDEX

One of the unique features of the NBU is the inclusion of an exhaustive “Subject Index”. The Subject Index provides details of all aspects of the subject matter of the listed items in the classified subject section. Each aspect of the subject is listed with a classification number.

For example, books on any subject and its related aspect can be located using the Dewey classification number from the “Classified Sequence Section”.

The subject Index is arranged in an alphabetical sequence with their classification numbers.

For example, a book on Biology and its related fields are treated as follows:

Biology 570

Examination, questions, etc 570.76

Experiments 570.78

Problems, exercises, etc 570.76

Research - periodicals 570.7205

Study and Teaching 570.7

Study and Teaching (Secondary) 570.712

CATALOGUING

The National Bibliography of Uganda (NBU) is compliant with both the Anglo-American Cataloguing Rules 2 (AACR2) and other standard texts for International Standard

DESCRIPTIVE CATALOGUING

All listed publications are given full bibliographic details of author's full name followed by year of birth (when known), full title, place of publication, Publisher's address

Detailed information about the collation – number of pages, volumes, kinds of illustrations, size and series is given. The frequency and the International Standard Serial Number (ISSN) is recorded for new serial titles.

INTERNATIONAL STANDARD BOOK NUMBER (ISBN)

The ISBN is a thirteen (13) digit structure assigned to identify a specific edition of a book or other monographic publication(s).

ISBN consists of five (5) parts:

ISBN = International Standard Book Number

978 = International Code

9970 = Country identifier – Uganda

9000 = Publisher identifier – Dol Enterprises

0 = Title identifier – The final republic

6 = Check digit (it provides for the computer an automatic check for the correctness of the ISBN)

Example: ISBN: 978-978-31704-0-6 (New 13 digits).

INTERNATIONAL STANDARD SERIAL NUMBER (ISSN)

The International Standard Serial Number (ISSN) is an eight (8) structure that identifies serials globally. The ISSN should be cited on all promotional and descriptive materials concerning the serial and should be in two groups of four (4) digits separated by a hyphen. For example, ISSN: 2141-4521.

TRACING

Using the Library of Congress list of Subject Headings, 31st edition, the subject analysis of each publication is provided on the next paragraph following the ISBN/ISSN, binding and price information.

The subject headings are preceded by Arabic numerals. Other added entries i.e additional author entries like joint authors and title information are numbered in

Roman numerals. These are to be used in preparing headings for Library catalogues and they indicate additional headings under which the publication may be represented and accessed in catalogues, e.g.:

- 1. Business - Religions aspects*
 - 2. Christianity - Economic aspects*
 - 3. Wealth - Biblical teaching*
- I. Title.*

CLASSIFICATION NUMBERS

All works listed are classified by the current editions of both the Library of Congress and Dewey Decimal Classification Scheme. For government publications, the National Library of Nigeria Classification Scheme is used in addition to the LC and Dewey Classification Schemes. Excerpts of the outlines of these classification schemes are given elsewhere in the preliminaries.

NATIONAL BIBLIOGRAPHY OF UGANDA (NBU)

A major requirement of the Universal Bibliographic Control (UBC) is the existence of effective facilities for the publication of a current national bibliography. The existence of the National Bibliography of Uganda dates back to 2003 when the National Library of Uganda was established.

It lists all books and publications in any format irrespective of size or language published in Uganda, about Uganda, or by Ugandans abroad and acquired by the National Library of Uganda. The National Bibliography of Uganda (NBU) lists the catalogue entries for all Ugandan materials Uganda received under the legal deposit during the year.

IMPORTANCE OF THE NBU

As it is expected, it serves as a Selection tool for library acquisition. The production of the NBU is in itself a very important bibliographic service. The appearance of a new title in the NBU has far reaching market implications for the publisher. The production of the NBU is a unique bibliographic function which no other library or institution is given the opportunity to perform. It is an important contribution aimed at achieving Universal Bibliographic Control (UBC) and Universal Availability of Publications (UAP). It is

*circulated both national and internationally. Each annual cumulation includes author/
title/series index, statistical tables, subject index, list of printers and publishers.*

Appendix

Guidelines and requirements for the assignment of ISBN

INTERNATIONAL STANDARD BOOK NUMBER

1. What is an ISBN (International Standard Book Number)?

An ISBN is a 13 –digit number that identifies a book for purposes of commerce and supply.

The ISBN is a unique international identifier for monographic (book) publications.it is a 13 digit –digit number e.g. 978-0-306-40615-0

2. What are the advantages of ISBN?

- Global ordering and distribution of books is mainly executed by ISBN
- Compilation and updating of book trade directories and bibliographic databases, such as cataloguing of books in print.
- Its need for the running of electronic point of sale systems in bookshops

3. Which materials should have ISBN?

- Monographs (books)
- E-publications.

4. Where to put the ISBN?

The thirteen (13) digit ISBN number is divided into five parts separated clearly by hyphens or spaces. E.g. 978-0-356-42615-0. This number should be printed on

- Verso title page of each publication
- Base of the title page
- Base of the spine
- The back of the cover in nine-point or larger
- The back of the dust-jacket and on the back of any other protector

5. Do books need ISBN, if they are not going to be sold?

It's desirable that **ALL** books are identified by ISBNs.

6. Does a change of format require a new ISBN?

Yes, different formats need different ISBNs.

7. I am revising a book. Does it require a new ISBN?

A significant change of text requires a new ISBN. If revisions have been made it should state on the verso of the title page that the book is revised edition and the new ISBN should be printed there.

8. Does a reprint without change of text or binding require a new ISBN?

No, not if there is no change of text, format, or building that would justify a new ISBN.

9. How are ISBNs allocated to multi-format/multi-volume works?

An ISBN must be allocated to the whole set of volumes of multi-volume work, as well as individual volumes of the set.

10. Do I need a new ISBN when I am reprinting a book with a new title?

Yes, a new title requires a new ISBN.

11. I am publishing a book with another Publisher. Whose ISBN should appear on the book?

In the case of Joint Publication, an ISBN is assigned by the publisher in charge of distribution.

12. I am not a Publisher- Can I still obtain an ISBN?

Yes, a Publisher is a group, organization, company or individual who is responsible for originating the product of a publication and also bears the cost/financial risk.

13. What are Publishers' obligations?

- Maintaining register of ISBN that have been assigned to published and forth coming books. This register should be kept in numerical sequence showing ISBN, Author, Title, Edition statements etc.
- Forwarding a list of publications with their used ISBN to the National Agency before asking for new assignment of ISBN.
- Delivering within one month of publication at his own expense to the National Library of Uganda, three copies of the book.

NATIONAL LIBRARY ACT 2003

The National Library Act 2003 applies throughout the country and has supremacy over any library Laws of state Government in the event of conflicts. Under this Act, the National Library as the National Bibliography Agency of Uganda was enjoined to receive three (3) and ten(10) copies of everything published in Uganda by private or State Agencies respectively within one month of publication at their own expense. It is also noteworthy that the UNESCO guidelines for the collection of legal deposit materials incorporated in the National Library Act of 2003 that is:

- i. Visits to Publishers
- ii. Examinations of announcements and advertisements in national and local newspapers
- iii. Liaison with government departments and government printing offices
- iv. Establishment of an effective clerical routine of registration, receipts, checks and follow ups.

WHO IS TO DEPOSIT?

There are three categories of publishers specified in the Act:

- i. Category 1: Private Publishers
- ii. Category 2: Federal Government: Ministries, Parastatals and Agencies.
- iii. Category 3: State Government: Ministries, Parastatals and Agencies

WHAT IS TO BE DEPOSITED?

Information source that is published in Uganda. The Act in Section 4 sub-section (7) defines the “BOOK” thus:

- i. “All literary works such as Books, Pamphlets, sheets of music, maps, charts, plans. tables and compilations.
- ii. Dramatic works.
- iii. Collective works such as Encyclopedias, Dictionaries, Year Books, Newspapers, Magazines and periodicals
- iv. All forms in which documentary or oral records are published. This means legal deposit is also for non-book materials, home videos, films, cassettes etc and even electronic publications.

The best copies of each publications should be deposited.

HOW MANY IS TO BE DEPOSITED

The number of copies of published materials to be deposited varies with categories of publishers.

- i. Private publishers are to deposit three (3) copies each of their publications.
- ii. Federal government and its agencies are to deposit twenty-five (25) copies each of their publications
- iii. State government and its agencies are to deposit ten (10) copies each of their publications.

BENEFITS OF LEGAL DEPOSIT

- i. Preservation of the Nations intellectual output for future generations
- ii. Bibliographic control of the Nations Publications
- iii. The Legal deposit materials collected are processed and listed in the National Bibliography of Uganda which is circulated both locally and internationally.
- iv. The AUTHOR's name will be entrenched in the annals of the Nation's publication history.
